Status update



- info:eu-repo namespace migration from SURF-Wiki to COAR
 - ✓ – Ownership of info:eu-repo at info-uri.info registry transferred to COAR
 - ⊕ – Adding COAR to the maintainers of purl.org id 'eu-repo/semantics' resolving to info-eu-repo terms still pending
- Web presence
 - COAR portal allows for internal documents, e.g. visible for IG members only
 - Public pages, editable by IG members

Application Profiles / Controlled Vocabularies



- “info:eu-repo” namespace application profile
 - implemented by numerous initiatives in Europe and beyond, e.g. OpenAIRE
- CERIF semantic types
 - Current Research Information System domain
 - Used to exchange publication, project, person, organisation information with OpenAIRE
- ESciDoc Application Profile Vocabulary Encoding Schemes for Publications
 - Implemented in the PubMan repository platform (e.g. Max Planck institutional repositories)
- Eprints Type Vocabulary Encoding Scheme
- Gemeinsames Vokabular für Publikations- und Dokumententypen
 - <http://nbn-resolving.de/urn:nbn:de:kobv:11-100109998>
 - Implemented in the German repository community and XMetaDissPlus
- RIOXX Application Profile
- V4OA



How can you contribute?



- Informally
 - Use the mailing list to share information under the scope of the IG
 - E.g. web-resources, publications covering vocabulary and interoperability topics

 - Become an editor for the IG knowledge base
 - Input needed for mappings, best practice examples

Authority Group workflow



1. Incoming request to add / modify / delete a term / encoding scheme
2. Checklist
 1. No duplicates
 2. No information loss
 3. Description is clear and unambiguous
 4. ...
3. Decision making
 1. If needed ask IG members and external experts
 2. Voting of Authority Group members
